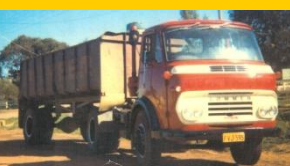

Benedict's new facility

The new Alexandria (South Sydney) facility recently purchased by Benedict has been a Waste Facility for some time now. Up until recently it was leased by another waste company that had no processing capabilities at all. This is evidenced by the large stockpile of waste material that they left on the site at the time of going bankrupt. To say the site needs a lot of work cleaning it up is an understatement. The owner of the premises took back control of the site and tried to start cleaning the facility up but soon realised he too had no cost effective way to do this and has had numerous ongoing issues with both Council and the NSW DECCW (EPA) ever since. As you can imagine the neighbouring businesses were also very unimpressed with the site in its current state. We have since met some of these neighbours and they are very happy with our plans to clean up the site and start operations the correct way. I.E minimal stock on site, dust controls in place etc. If you look at the photo, the yellow wall will be painted in the standard Benedict grey, a new large Benedict Recycling sign similar to Chipping Norton will go on the wall, and gardens will also be introduced out the front as well.



We have long recognised that Benedict Recycling was potentially missing out on additional waste and more importantly additional revenue in this area. Our customers also asked many times, "when are you going to get a facility in the eastern suburbs". It will take us close to a month to empty the site utilising the Chipping Norton Facility. Once we are operational we will then start offering the site to a few of our current larger customers whilst targeting heavily the surrounding Councils and other Government utilities such as the RTA, Sydney Water, Railcorp, Energy Australia etc.

The site will also have a few drop in desks for the Benedict Reps to do some work from their laptops when they are in the area.

This new facility completes the loop for Benedict Recycling and now gives us facilities right across the major areas of the Sydney area
